GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Each application package should be tailored to address the specific criteria and intentions of each scholarship.

The scholarship committee encourages students to look near and far in identifying directed investigations, focused research, and service opportunities to dedicate your scholarship towards. Global thinking and visioning is supported, while the committee recognizing the constraints of the pandemic. Applicants are encouraged to utilize faculty expertise in developing applications and specific lines of inquiry.

Students are encouraged to apply for as many scholarships as they qualify for (based on economic need, GPA, and/or other qualifying criteria). We welcome applicants who are citizens or eligible non-citizens per California Dream Act Application (CADAA) - AB540 to apply for the department's scholarships. For scholarships that consider demonstrated need, a current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Wednesday, March 1, 2023

Apply via the Bronco Student Application (BSA) website: <https://csupomona.academicworks.com/>.

Reviewing Criteria

- 1) All scholarships require a complete BSA application to be considered, unless noted in the criteria.
- 2) Each scholarship applied for requires a bespoke **one-page statement of intent responding to the specific scholarship descriptions**. Generic statements will be scored lower than well-written statements addressing the intentions of the scholarship.



- 3) **Digital Portfolio** (8 two-page spreads, A4 size, 32mb maximum) is required for all scholarships over \$1,000. Applications without the portfolio will be scored lower. Well curated and composed portfolios will earn stronger scores.
- 4) Short **letters of references** are required by some scholarships. Applications for these scholarships without all letters will be scored lower.
- 5) **Additional application content and requirements** are set forth in the scholarship descriptions, these may include a current resume, a formal headshot, research budget, and the number of letters of support that are required or optional. Incomplete applications will be scored lower.

Post-Award Obligations for Scholarship Recipients

- Scholarship recipients will be notified in April that they should attend the CPPLA Awards Ceremony in May 2023. **Recipients are requested to submit a photograph or personal representation** (1600 x 1600 pixels or larger .jpg or .png) by **May 1st** for use in the Scholarship Ceremony, CPPLA social media, and the ENV website.
- All students awarded scholarships must submit digital copies of a thank you letter and other application materials to the Landscape Architecture Department by **June 1, 2023** (unless noted otherwise).
- Recipients of scholarships **more than \$1,000** are required to make a public presentation about their findings/activities at a Department event in Spring 2024.

Award of Landscape Architecture Department Scholarships are at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and Department, who reserve the right to determine the eligibility of all applicants, and to partially or fully distribute scholarship funds.

Distribution of scholarship funds is contingent on the applicant enrolling in BSLA or MLA course in Fall 2023 as a full-time or part-time student per the specific scholarship criteria. Students graduating in Spring 2023, or who have completed the BSLA or MLA studio sequence before Fall 2023 are not eligible to receive departmental scholarships.

DON BRINKERHOFF SCHOLARSHIP

To provide unrestricted scholarship support to an undergraduate landscape architecture student who has demonstrated a strong level of academic achievement and a calculated financial need. This scholarship will be awarded to an individual who is a self-starter, leader, team player, and multi-disciplinary in focus. Minority, first-generation students, and women candidates are particularly encouraged to apply.

Don Brinkerhoff (1931-2021) founded Lifescapes International, Inc., the award-winning international landscape architectural firm headquartered in Newport Beach, CA. Lifescapes has designed and implemented more than 1200 projects throughout the world, including casino resorts in Las Vegas such as The Mirage, Caesars Palace, Encore Boston Harbor, Pechanga Resort and Casino, Channel Gardens at Rockefeller Center, Choctaw Casino & Resort- Durant, Fontainebleau Miami Beach, The Venetian Resort Las Vegas and The Venetian Macao, The Grove, Hotel Drovers & Fort Worth Stockyards, and many many more.

An alumnus of Cal Poly Pomona, Don Brinkerhoff '52 and the Brinkerhoff family have funded scholarships for the College of Environmental Design and College of Agriculture students for many years. Mr. Brinkerhoff benefitted from scholarship support while a student at Cal Poly Pomona, and credited that opportunity with making the difference in his academic and professional career. He would not have been able to finish his studies had he NOT received a scholarship.

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time BSLA student currently in the second or third year of the program.
- 3.0 GPA or better
- Demonstrated financial need
- Citizen or non-citizen (eligible for security clearance)

Requirements

- Completed BSA application
- Letter of intent including intended study objectives and the relationship of these objectives to the applicant's career goals
- Current resume
- A4 Size digital portfolio:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages)
 - Portfolio projects that support application
- Two brief letters of reference from persons outside the Department of Landscape Architecture

Post-award requirements will include a thank-you letter to donor, along with a report and public presentation of findings/activities within one year. It may also include a meeting at Lifescapes.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a digital copy of portfolio and thank you letter to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023.

Distribution

One \$10,000 award. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this scholarship and selecting the recipient.

DANGERMOND RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

These fellowships are to expand the intellectual horizons of Landscape Architecture students through the research and study of **internationally significant works of Landscape Architecture or Geodesign**. Fellowship objectives can focus on research into: a particular designer or group of designers representing an identified landscape theory, style, or transition of styles; works that are exemplary in their application of ecological design, sustainability, or regenerative principles; innovative works or projects related to or using Geographic Information Systems (GIS) in their design or function; or works that expand the practice of landscape architecture. Compelling proposals on other topics developed by the applicant will also be considered. Funds can be used for travel, and/or research related expenses.

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time BSLA or MLA students.

Specific Application Requirements

- Completed **BSA Application**.
- **Statement of Intent** (two-pages max) with well-developed research objective(s), description of expected products/deliverables from the fellowship, and the relationship of these objectives to the applicant's career goals.
- **Research Budget** (two-pages max) and budget narrative describing specific research or travel related expenses identified in the statement. Research expenses should include a description of the item(s)/activity. Stipend/living expenses can be included in the budget. For travel related expenses, a proposed itinerary listing destinations, tentative dates of travel, travel mode (car, train, air, et cetera), and names of any persons to be visited during the trip, especially designers, academics, officials, or other experts.
- **Current resume** (one-page).
- **Digital portfolio**:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages) in a single PDF.
 - Projects are a curated selection of work that relate to the fellowship objectives.
- Two (brief) **letters of reference** from persons outside the Department of Landscape Architecture.

Post-award requirements include a thank-you letter to donor, report of findings/activities (delivered to the Department by the end of Fall 2023), and a public presentation (Spring 2023).

Fellowship recipients must provide a hard copy of their portfolio, statement of intent, budget/itinerary and thank you letter, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023. The report on findings/activities must be submitted to the department by the end of Fall Semester 2022, unless an extension is requested. All research activities should be completed in 2022.

Distribution

Up to **TEN \$5,000 fellowships will be awarded**. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this research fellowship and selecting the recipient(s).

RUTH SHELLHORN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is provided to fund one or more students who have shown dedication to landscape architecture and an appreciation for plant material as an integral part of design. Preference will be given to students in need of financial assistance in order to finish their education. The amounts of the scholarship shall be determined by the faculty and in consideration of the greatest need, to a maximum of \$5,000 annually.

The scholarship is established in memory of [Ruth Shellhorn](#), the first professionally trained woman landscape architect of the Southern California Chapter of the ASLA and one of the first female Fellows of the American Society of Landscape Architects.

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time BSLA or MLA students.
- 3.0 or better Major GPA.
- Demonstrated financial need.

Specific Application Requirements

- Completed **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically describing dedication to leadership within the discipline of Landscape Architecture and personal philosophy towards plant materials and design.
- Current **resume**.
- **Digital portfolio**:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 pages total).
 - Portfolio projects that support application.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a digital portfolio, and all required documents including thank you letter, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023. A presentation must be made within one year of receiving the scholarship.

Distribution

Two \$2,500 awards, or in any other amount determined by Scholarship Committee based upon applications to the maximum of \$5,000 annually. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds.

This scholarship is administered jointly by the department who selects the recipients and the [Landscape Architecture Foundation](#). The Landscape Architecture Foundation will distribute scholarship funds directly to the recipients.

B.L.A.C.K. in L.A. SCHOLARSHIP

To address the history of racism and discrimination in planning and design practices of the past, the profession of landscape architecture must broaden career opportunities and amplify voices, experiences, and perspectives beyond what is found in the current discourse of environmental design.

In recognition of this need, students, faculty and alumni of the Department of Landscape Architecture have established the **BRAVELY LEADING ADVANCEMENT, CURIOSITY, AND KNOWLEDGE IN LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE** (B.L.A.C.K. in L.A.) scholarship to prioritize a future that is community-focused, equitable, relevant, and sustainable.

B.L.A.C.K. in L.A. scholarship supports the University's commitment to diversity and inclusion, by making higher education more accessible with one \$3,000 scholarship to encourage students from diverse and/or socially and economically disadvantaged backgrounds pursue a Landscape Architecture education. Looking towards this desired future, the scholarship will be awarded annually to a **new student** in the Landscape Architecture major (undergraduate or graduate) who has demonstrated an interest in supporting, or involvement with, equity and inclusion efforts that benefit the long-term diversification of the discipline.

Eligibility Criteria

- Incoming, transfer, or current student to the BSLA or MLA program.
- 3.0 or better Major GPA.
- Demonstrated financial need.
- Interest in supporting, or involvement with, equity and inclusion efforts that benefit the long-term diversification of the discipline.

Specific Application Requirements

- Completed **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically addressing the applicant's educational goals, financial need and the opportunity afforded by the scholarship.
- **Digital portfolio**:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages).
 - Portfolio projects that support application and applicant's design capabilities.

Post-award requirements will include a thank-you letter to donor and a public presentation of work/ideas supported by the funds.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a copy of portfolio and all required documents including thank you letter to the Landscape Architecture Department office. The presentation must be made within one year of receiving the scholarship.

Distribution

One \$3,000 award. Enrollment in at least 6-units in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this scholarship and selecting the recipient(s).

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time BSLA or MLA students.
- Financial need.
- Leadership potential.
- Community involvement.
- 3.0 or better Major GPA.

Specific Application Requirements

- Completed **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically addressing the applicant's educational goals, financial need and the opportunity afforded by the scholarship.
- **Digital portfolio**:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages).
 - Portfolio projects that support application and applicant's design capabilities.
- **Formal color photograph headshot** (at least 2400 by 3000 pixels, high quality .jpg or .png file) for use in the Scholarship Awards Ceremony, Department's Website, and by the CLASS Fund. See [classfund.org](https://www.classfund.org).

Post-award requirements will include a thank-you letter to donor and a public presentation of work/ideas supported by the funds.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a hard copy of the portfolio, the full application, and a thank you letter to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023. The presentation must be made within one year of receiving the scholarship.

Distribution

Two \$2,500 awards. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds.

This scholarship was established by the family and classmates of Grisol Lupita Ramirez, a beloved and distinguished member of BSLA Class of 2018, who was taken from the Cal Poly Pomona and broader design community too soon in a car accident on the night of January 5th, 2019.

The intent of this award is to keep the memory and spirit of Grisol Lupita Ramirez alive - "My dreams don't have borders, only spaces to design." Applicants should reflect the qualities and characteristics with which Grisol sincerely identified – first-generation college students, demonstrating determined improvement throughout their first 3-years in college, and consistently striving to build a better future for their family.

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time 3rd-year BSLA students anticipating graduation in Spring 2024
- Must demonstrate financial need.
- First-generation college student who started as a first-time freshman at CPP.
- 2.5 or better Major GPA.

Specific Application Requirements

- Complete **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically addressing the applicant's educational experience and goals, future directions, and specific intentions for the funds.
- **Digital portfolio** demonstrating improvement over the first three years in the BSLA program:
 - Maximum of 8-page-spreads of A4 size (16 total pages).
 - Portfolio must show improvement throughout the three years in the program.
- (Optional) two brief **letters of recommendations** from applicant's instructors from 2 of the 3 courses which were Grisol's favorite:
 - Construction.
 - Plant ID/Design.
 - Design Studio.

Post-award requirements include a thank-you letter to Grisol's family, and a public presentation.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a hard copy of the portfolio and all required documents including the thank you letter, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023. The presentation must be made within one year of receiving the scholarship.

Distribution

One \$2,000 award. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this scholarship and selecting the recipient with input from Grisol's family and friends.

Eligibility Criteria

- Full-time BSLA or MLA students.
- Incoming MLA Students are welcome to apply.
- 2.5 or better Major GPA.

Specific Application Requirements

- Complete **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically describing the community service project that the applicant wishes to undertake and the implications of the work on the applicant's future directions within the discipline of Landscape Architecture.
- **Digital portfolio** (PDF) featuring designs for community related projects:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages).
 - Portfolio projects that support the application.For each project in the portfolio:
 - Identify the course number/term, instructor, and team members.
 - Provide a short project statement including: description of the community being served, community members or groups associated with the project, a timeline/itinerary for the project, the intended results/deliverables for the project.

Post-award requirements will include a **thank-you letter to donor (Dennis Otsugi)**, **report of findings**, and a **public presentation** of findings/discoveries/outcomes in Spring 2023.

If selected for award, recipients must provide the thank you letter, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023. Report of findings/presentation must be provided to the department within one year of receiving the scholarship.

Distribution

One \$1,500 award. Full-time enrollment (12-units or more) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this scholarship and selecting the recipient.

- 3.0 or better Major GPA.

Specific Application Requirements

- Complete **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically addressing the **applicant's educational goals, future directions, and specific intentions for the funds**.
- **Digital portfolio** (PDF) welcome but not required:
 - Maximum of 8-page spreads of A4 size (16 total pages).
 - Portfolio projects that demonstrates the applicants design capabilities.

Post-award requirements will include a thank-you letter to the Uesugi family and a public presentation of work/ideas supported by the funds.

If selected for award, recipients must provide a hard copy of portfolio and all required documents including thank you letter, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023.

Distribution

One \$1,000 award. Enrollment in at least 6-units in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

This scholarship is to provide financial support for students with a demonstrated interest and commitment to the discipline and profession of landscape architecture, who are starting their academic journey in either the BSLA or the MLA program at Cal Poly Pomona. Students can apply for this scholarship during the admissions process (including transferring applications).

Eligibility Criteria

- Newly admitted or transfer BSLA or MLA students or
- Current BSLA or MLA students who are enrolled at least half-time (6-units/semester).
- A minimum of 3.0 major GPA or 3.0 GPA for the latest 60 semester units as documented in the admission application or transferring process.
- Demonstrated financial need.

Specific Application Requirements

- Complete **BSA application**.
- **Letter of intent** specifically addressing the **applicant's educational goals, financial need** and the **opportunity afforded by the scholarship**. Incoming/transferring students can include their admission application materials for this purpose.
- Digital portfolio is welcome but not required.

Post-award requirements will include a thank-you letter to donor, submitted to the Department Landscape Architecture office by June 1, 2023.

Distribution

Two \$1,000 awards. Part-time enrollment (at least 6-units) in Fall 2023 is required to receive the funds. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

Required Eligibility Criteria

- Enrollment in the **Landscape Architecture Italy Program** as a full-time 4th Year **BSLA** student from Cal Poly Pomona or Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.
- 3.0 or higher Major GPA.

Specific Application Requirements

- **One-page letter** describing:
 1. **Why you want to take part in the Italy Program,**

 3. The **impact the scholarship** would have in helping you achieve those goals.
- *General BSA Application is not required.*
- *No portfolio required.*

Chapman Travel Scholarship Applications are DUE by: JUNE 1, 2023

Up notification of award, recipients must provide a **thank you letter** addressed to the Chapman Forestry Foundation sent by email to LA@CPP.edu by 8/1/2022. Post-award requirements include giving a **public presentation** about their travels (students who are graduating immediately after participating in the Italy program will need record a video presentation about their experience that is submitted to the department by June 1, 2023).

Distribution

Maximum of **fifteen awards at \$1,000** each to students enrolled in the Fall 2023 Italy Program.

Awards contingent upon approval of and participation in the Cal Poly Pomona Landscape Architecture Study Abroad Program in Castiglion Fiorentino, Italy. Scholarships will not be awarded if the program is cancelled for any reason. Scholarship funds will be distributed by CPP on 8/15/23.

The Cal Poly Pomona Department of Landscape Architecture Scholarship Committee is responsible for administering this scholarship. Recipients will be selected from the eligible applicants by the Chapman Forestry Foundation.
